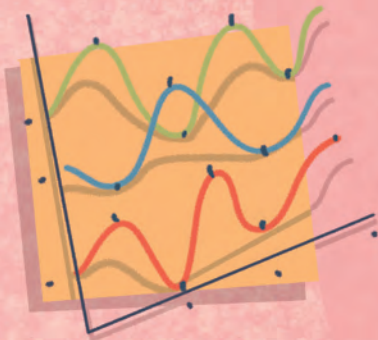


Do you ever have a question

or what may cause a drought?

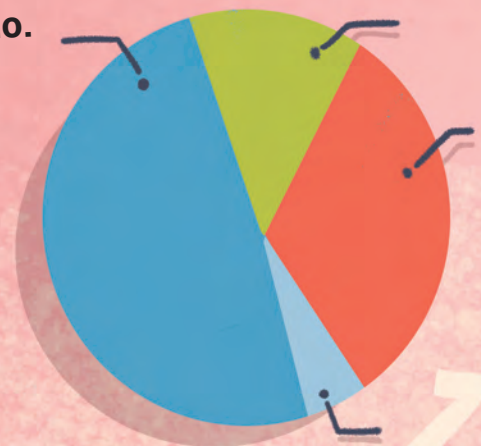


When we work or play,
