- Reproducible pages appropriate for students in one or more of grades 5–9
- Notes for the teacher, including a suggested launch, guidelines, and questions

Authors are encouraged to include any of the following:

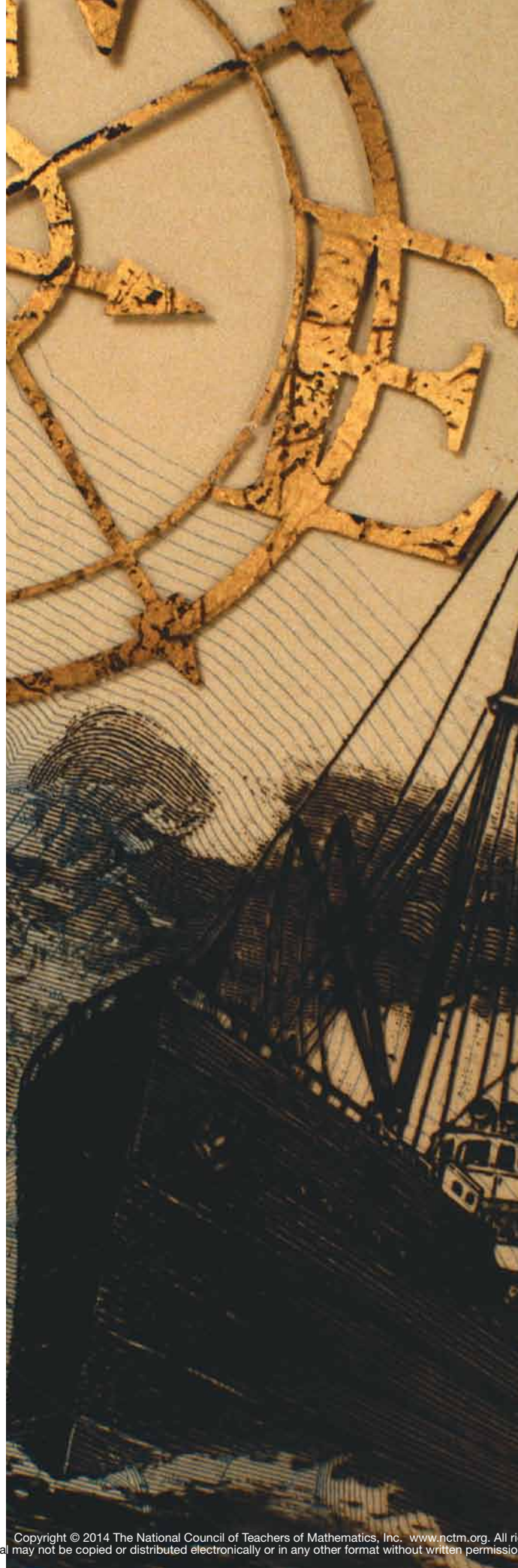
- Examples of difficulties that students encountered and, possibly, ideas for dealing with those difficulties
- Suggestions for assessing student learning
- Ideas for extensions of the exploration
- A related activity for follow-up family use at home

The manuscript should be no more than 1500 words. Include figures and activity sheets at the end. Submit manuscripts by accessing mtms.msubmit.net. On the tab titled Keywords, Categories, Special Sections, scroll to “Manuscript Type,” make your choice, then scroll down to “Departments/Calls” and select Mathematical Explorations.

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
