Investigations

Would you like to share how your students approached an open-ended problem? The “Investigations” department is designed to showcase students’ thinking and work.

Include the following in your article:

- a short summary of each task, including goals, materials, questions, and anticipated responses;
- a mechanism for students to record their work, their thinking, or both;
- students’ and teachers’ reflections, recommendations, and cautionary advice; and
- students’ actual work samples, photographs of these, or both.

Clearly describe—

- activities that could easily be used by elementary teachers, mathematics coaches, or school-based mathematics specialists; and
- considerations for acceleration and intervention.

Manuscripts for this department are limited to 2500 words (figures, references, and relevant student work samples are not included in the word count).
