Submissions should include the following:

- A description of the exploration, including goals or objectives
- Reproducible pages appropriate for students in one or more of grades 5–9
- Notes for the teacher, including a suggested launch, guidelines, and questions

Authors are encouraged to include any of the following:

- Examples of difficulties that students encountered and, possibly, ideas for dealing with those difficulties
- Suggestions for assessing student learning
- Ideas for extensions of the exploration
- A related activity for follow-up family use at home

The manuscript should be no more than 1500 words. Include figures and activity sheets at the end. Submit manuscripts by accessing **mtms.msubmit.net**. On the tab titled Keywords, Categories, Special Sections, scroll to “Manuscript Type,” make your choice, then scroll down to “Departments/Calls” and select Mathematical Explorations.
