

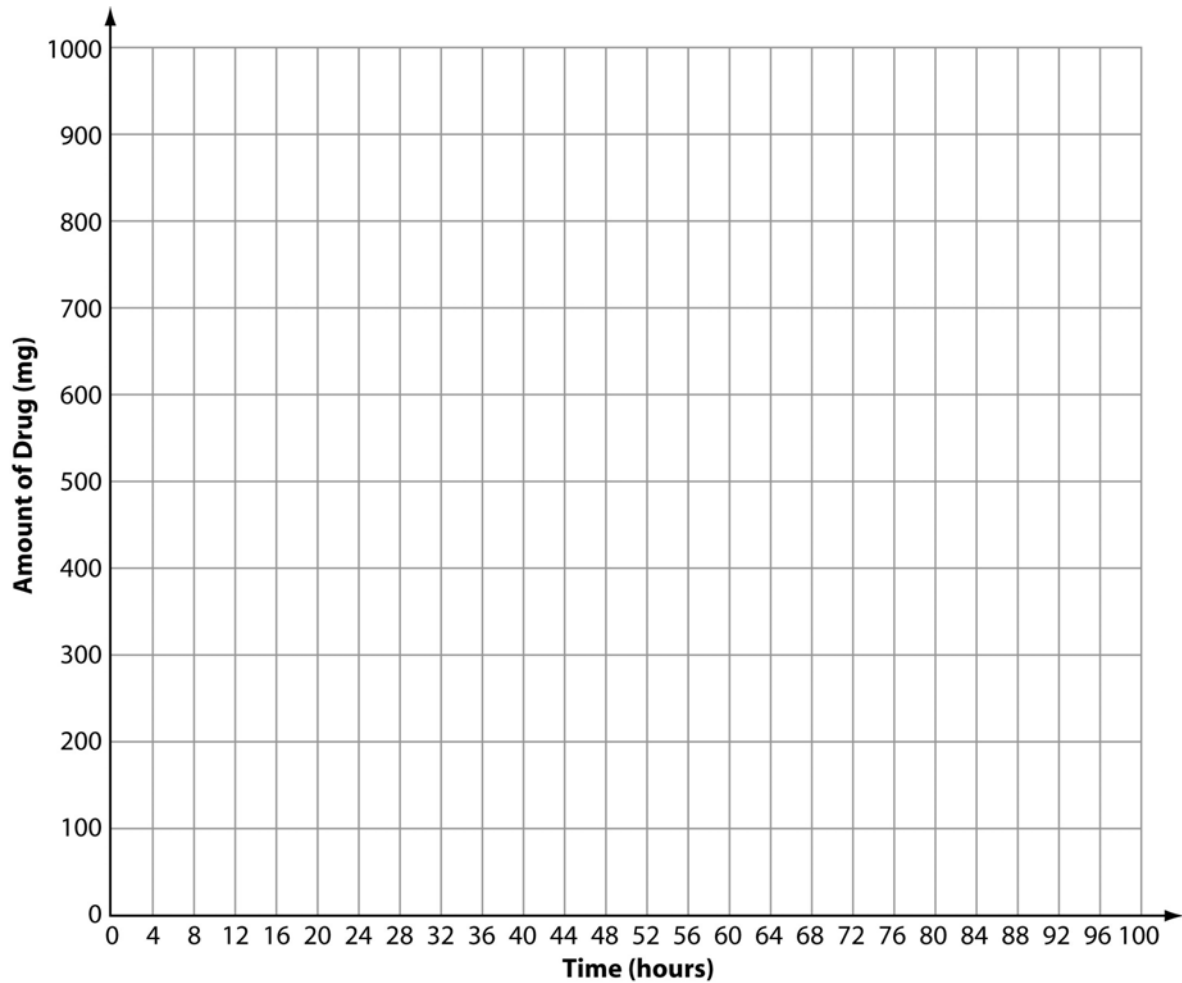
Drug Filtering
